The Haystack Prayer Meeting

In 1806, in Williamstown, Massachusetts, a student at Williams College named Samuel Mills began to pray for the cause of foreign missions. Until then, the missionary organizations in the United States were solely dedicated to domestic missions, both in the Western frontier and among Native American tribes. But Mills prayed that the Lord would raise up men and women to take the gospel to other nations.

One August day, Mills assembled a small group of spiritually minded friends who prayed together outside of campus for foreign missions. Some accounts say there was a sudden thunderstorm as they were praying, which caused the five young men to take refuge under a haystack.

Afterward, they continued to gather weekly for what became known as the Haystack Prayer Meeting. In answer to the prayers from among the haystacks, God established the American Board of Commissioners of Foreign Missions, the American Bible Society, and the United Foreign Missionary Society. Through those organizations, the Lord sent many laborers into his ripened field.

The Haystack Prayer Meeting was the beginning of the modern missionary movement. Over the next fifty years, thousands of young believers from New England committed their lives to foreign mission. They went to the Near East, India, Africa, and China, carrying the good news of Jesus Christ, establishing churches, and translating the Bible into many languages.
