I) Introduction - Exiled from the Presence of God

II) The Text - Isaiah 59:14-20 and Matthew 1:23

A) Isaiah 59:14-20 - Judgement and Redemption
OT commentator Brevard Childs on Isaiah 59:20.

"the covenant does not rest on human wish or need but on divine determination."

B) Matthew 1:23 - What does Matthew mean by Immanuel, God with us?

III) Application - Letting our light shine through the presence of God in Christ.

A) Stanzas 1 and 3 (past) - God promised to end Israel's exile and all of humanities spiritual exile. That promise is fulfilled in Jesus' first Advent!

B) Stanza 4 (present) - Christians still walk in the night that's shrouded in darkness. However, we have the presence of Christ with us!

C) Stanza 5 (future) - God's promise to "open wide our heavenly home" gives us hope as Christians. We look forward to Christ's last Advent!

IV) Closing - While we listen to O Come, O Come, Emmanuel, ask the Lord to give us a spirit that rejoices! In many ways, that is why the hymn repeats those words five times! The Lord will come back to Zion and exile will be done away with forever!
