SERMON NOTES

"The Sixth Commandment"

I) Introduction - "For murder destroys the very image of God; because man is created to the similitude and likeness of God." Heinrich Bullinger (1504-1575).

II) The Text - Exodus 20:13

A) 1st Qualifier - This commandment is not speaking about the magistrate or what we normally call the state (Romans 13:1-7).

B) 2nd Qualifier - Israel's vocation is to follow the Lord's commands and to become a special people. This is true with regards to honoring the Lord who gives life and who takes it away.

C) The better rendering is murder not kill as the older translators argued.

III) The Problem? We live in a culture that loves violence.

IV) Application - How to deal with the "body" of anger (Matthew 5:21-26)?

A) The Mind - Anger often starts in our minds. See 1 Corinthians 10:5.

B) The Heart - Anger proceeds to move into our hearts. As it does that, our lips utter curses to our neighbor. See: James 3:8-10.

C) The Hands - If anger captures our hearts, it can move to our hands. See: Exodus 20:13.

V) Closing - Christians are to be peacemakers in the step with Matthew 5:9!
