James 1:17 - "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change."

II) The Text - The Eighth Commandment - Exodus 20:15

A) The commandment is negative and does not permit an individual to take another's possession(s).

B) The nuance of "to steal" is associated with the words stealth, sudden, and hidden.

C) What are the consequences? Restitution. We will unpack this idea (See: Exodus 22:1-2; Lev 6:1-7).
